Every part of the Land of Israel was given by Hashem to the different שְׁבָּטִים (tribes) of the בְּנִי יִשְׂרָאֵל (Children of Israel).

But what about the holy city of יְרוּשְׁלַיִם (Jerusalem)? Which tribe does it belong to?

Some תְּנָאִים (Sages of the Mishna era) say Jerusalem does not belong to any tribe in particular.
Since the land does not belong

to anyone, Jerusalem

homeowners cannot rent

their homes out to visitors.

Other תַּנְאִים say that Jerusalem was divided between the tribes of בְּנָמִין (Judah) and בְּנָמִין (Benjamin).

The parts that belonged to יְהוּדָה were: הַבּיִת (Temple Mount), the אָטְכוֹת (chambers) and the אָזְרוֹת (courtyards). The parts that belonged to בּּנְיָמִין were: the אוּלָם (Hall), the (Sanctuary) and the קֿיָשׁ הַקְּדָשִׁים (Holy of Holies).

The spot of the מְוְבֵּחַ (Altar) originally belonged to יְהוּדָה, but בְּיָמִין was very pained by this and wanted to have the holy place in his territory. Hashem granted his desire.

We have mentioned how, seven days before יום כפור, the בהן גדול had another

סה standby to take his place if he becomes אָמֵא (impure) and cannot perform the יוֹם בִּפוּר

But what happens to that other פֿהֵן after the פֿהֵן returns to his post?

According to רַבִּי מֵאִיר, the standby פֿהַן keeps all the


rules of the פֿהֵן גָדוֹל, even after the real פֿהֵן returns. This means he may never

marry a widow, mourn for dead relatives, and must wear the special clothing of the בֹהֵן גָדוֹל

whenever he does the אֲבוֹדָה (Temple Service.)

למֵן says the standby רַבִּי יוֹסֵי does not keep the rules of the המן גָדוֹל. He also does not go back to his position as a regular פֿמֵן. This is because of the rule, "מַנְלִין בַּקוֹדֶשׁ וְאֵין "We bring people up in holiness and not down." Since the standby יוֹסֵין was

once at a high level of holiness as פֿהֵן גָדוֹל, we do not make him go down to the level of a regular בָּהֶן, again.
