R. Yosef Sebag, a Ben Torah and Yarei Shamayim who has already authored a number of fine works including a translation of Chovos HaLevovos, has written a book of stories about tzadikkim. It is, however, quite different from the normal works we encounter. Klal Yisrael has been blessed with numerous biographies of gedolim, the great leaders of our people who guide and direct us. For the most part, these are famous widely-recognized Roshei Yeshiva, Chassidic Rebbes, Rabbonim, Poskim and sometimes even an occasional lay leader of great distinction. But there is another category of tzadik -an Eved Hashem, totally attached to his Creator with intense passionate love, living a life of unbelievable holiness but without a yeshiva or community that he leads. Unknown to most people, these tzadikkim may often be simple laborers-cheesemakers cobblers, tailors, street cleaners, people we might not even notice. And yet we have a tradition that in every generation there are 36 hidden tzadikkim in whose merit the world endures. While none of us can ever know for sure who "makes" the list, R. Yosef gives us truly amazing stories of hidden tzadikkim who may very well qualify. Humble, quiet, simple, physically present on earth but, like angels, rooted in Heaven. It is important to know that such people still exist as a living testimony to what a Jew is capable of becoming.
