
If you have ever been to a wedding, surely you have seen the wedding canopy under which the bride and groom were married. This wedding canopy is called a "חוּפָּה"."

When a bride and groom stand under a חוֹפָּה, in a way their marriage begins. For example, only a מהן and his family may eat special תְּרוֹמָה foods (tithes) given to them by the rest of the Jewish people. This means, a בֹּהֵן's daughter may eat תְּרוֹמָה, but only as long as she is not married. Once married (to a non-בַּהוֹן) she may no longer eat תְּרוֹמָה.

Not only may she not eat תְּרוּמָה if she marries a non-בּהֵן, but also if she marries a whom she is not allowed to marry. For example, if the לַהֵן's daughter is divorced, she may not marry a בָּהֵן. If she does, she may not eat the תְּרוּמָה of her father's house.

What if she didn't fully marry the פֿהֵן but just went under the חופָה with him?

אב בב says that the חוּפָּה disqualifies the כֹהֵן's daughter from eating הרוּמָה the same as marrying the wasn't allowed to marry.





Can a מְמְיֵר Marry a Convert?

Non-Jews who convert to Judaism are full-fledged Jews. But there is a debate between מרבי and רְבִּי יִחוֹדָה if they are part of the "congregation of Hashem."

says converts are part of the "congregation of Hashem" and רַבּי יוֹסֵי says they are not.

What difference does it make whether or not someone is part of the "congregation of Hashem?" Certain people, such as a מֵמְנֵר, are not allowed to marry any Jew who is part of the "congregation of Hashem." So, according to מַמְנֵר a, רַבִּי יְהִידָה may not marry a convert, but according to מַמְנֵר a, רַבִּי יוֹסֵי, may marry a convert.
