Inside the Daf

If you have ever been to a wedding, surely you have seen the wedding canopy under which the bride and groom were married. This wedding canopy is called a "חופה."

When a bride and groom stand under a חופה, in a way their marriage begins. For example, only a כהן and his family may eat special תרומה foods (tithes) given to them by the rest of the Jewish people. This means, a כהן's daughter may eat תרומה, but only as long as she is not married. Once married (to a non-כהן) she may no longer eat תרומה.

Not only may she not eat תרומה if she marries a non-כהן, but also if she marries a כהן whom she is not allowed to marry. For example, if the כהן's daughter is divorced, she may not marry a כהן. If she does, she may not eat the תרומה of her father's house.

What if she didn't fully *marry* the כהן but just went under the חופה with him?

רב says that the חופה disqualifies the כהן's daughter from eating תרומה the same as marrying the כהן she wasn't allowed to marry.

שמואל says that even if the כהן's daughter went under the חופה with this man, she may still eat the תרומה of her father's house.

A כהן's daughter may eat תרומה as long as she is not married and living in her father's house



Did You Know...

רב is called "אבא" as a sign of authority and respect.



A Matter of מחלוקת

Can a ממזר Marry a Convert?

Non-Jews who convert to Judaism are full-fledged Jews. But there is a debate between רבי יוסי and רבי יהודה if they are part of the "congregation of Hashem."

רבי יהודה says converts are part of the "congregation of Hashem" and רבי יוסי says they are not.

What difference does it make whether or not someone is part of the "congregation of Hashem?" Certain people, such as a ממזר, are not allowed to marry any Jew who is part of the "congregation of Hashem." So, according to רבי יהודה, a ממזר may not marry a convert, but according to רבי יוסי, a ממזר may marry a convert.
