Coming Back Home

What a privilege to be a לכחי In addition to other benefits, a כחי and his family may eat the family may eat the tithe which must be separated from the other Jews' crops.

Of course, while a לכהן's daughter lives at home,

she too may partake of תְּרוּמָה. Once she marries a non-תְרוּמָה, she may no longer eat הַרוּמָה.

But what happens if the כֹּהֵן's daughter is widowed or divorced from the non-כֹּהֵן husband? In that case, she returns to her father's home and may once again eat קרוּמָה. The Torah tells us this in a פָּסוּק (verse) that if she is widowed or divorced, "She will return to her father's house as in her youth [and] she may eat of her father's bread [that is, קרוּמָה]."
