



# Inside the Daf

After the פֿהֵן גָּדוֹל reads the Torah in public he says eight בָּרָכוֹת (blessings) about:

The Torah

בָּרוּדְ אַתָּה הי אֱלֹקֵינוּ מֶלֶדְ הָעוֹלָם, אֲשֶׁר נָתַן לָנוּ תּוֹרַת אֱמֶת, וְחַיֵּי עוֹלָם נָטַע בְּתוֹכָנוּ. בָּרוּדְ אַתָּה הי, נוֹתֵן הַתּוֹרָה.

"Blessed are You Hashem, our God, King of the Universe, Who has given us the Torah of truth and had planted eternal life in our midst. Blessed are You Hashem, giver of the Torah."

ָרְצֵה בְּעַמְּךָ יִשְׂרָאֵל וְתִּרְצֶה הָעֲבוֹדָה בִּדְבִיר בֵּיתָדְ... שֶׁאוֹתְדָּ לְבַדְּדְּ בִּיִרְאָה נַעֲבוֹד.

Temple Sacrifices (עֻבוֹדָה):

"Be pleased with Your nation Israel and favor the service in the Holy of Holies of Your House...for You alone we serve in awe."



#### Thanksgiving (הּוֹדָאָה):

מוֹדִים אֲנָחָנוּ לָדְ... הַטוֹב לִדְּ לְהוֹדוֹת

"We give thanks to You...the One to whom it is good to give thanks."

מְחַל לַעֲוֹנוֹתָינוּ בִּיוֹם הַכִּפְּרִים הַזֶּה... מֶלֶדְ מוֹחֵל וְסוֹלֵחַ לַעֲוֹנוֹתָינוּ ...

Forgiving Sins (מָחָילַת הֶעַוּן):

"Forgive our sins on this day of atonement...the King who forgives and pardons our sins."





#### The Temple (מָקָדָשׁ):

בָּרוּדְ אַתָּה ה׳ אֱלֹקִינוּ מֶלֶדְ הָעוֹלָם שֶׁבָּחַר בַּמִקְדָשׁ

"Blessed are You Hashem King of the Universe Who has chosen the Temple."

ַבָּרוּדְ אַתָּה ה׳ אֱלֹקֵינוּ מֶלֶדְ הָעוֹלָם שֶׁבָּחַר בְּזַרְעוֹ שֶׁל אַהֲרֹן

The בּהַנִים:

"Blessed are You Hashem King of the Universe Who has chosen the seed of Aaron."





### The Israelites (יִשְׂרָאֵל):

בּרוּךְ אַתָּה הי הַבּוֹחֵר בְּיִשְׂרָאֵל 🚉

"Blessed are You Hashem Who chooses Israel."

ָרנָה תַּחִינָה בַּקָשָה מִלְפָנֵיךּ עַל עַמִּךְ יִשְׂרָאֵל שֵׁצְרִיכִין לְהַנָּשֵע, בָּרוּדְ אַתַּה ה׳ שוֹמֵעַ תִּפְלָּה

Hearing Prayer (שׁוּמֵעַ תִּפְלָּה):

"Prayer, supplication and requests before you for Your people Israel who need to be saved. Blessed are You Hashem Who hears prayer."







## Last Call

The יום כפור service... service...



1) The פֿהֵן גָּדוֹל, wearing his golden clothes, would offer his ram and the ram of the nation



2) The יַלְשֵׁם' (male goat) offering (not the 'לַשֵּׁם' goat which was already sacrificed!)



3) Washes hands and feet – removes golden clothing – immerses (4<sup>th</sup> time) – puts on white clothes – washes hands and feet



4) Enters קֹדֶשׁ הַקְּדָשִׁים (Holy of Holies) to remove the incense ladle and coal pan



5) Washes hands and feet – removes white clothing – immerses (5<sup>th</sup> time) – puts on gold clothes – washes hands and feet



6) Enters הֵיכָל (Sanctuary) to burn the afternoon אָטֹרֶת (incense) and light the מְנוֹרָה lamps



7) Washes hands and feet – removes golden clothes – puts on regular clothes



8) He is escorted home and has a feast that night for his loved ones to celebrate making it out of the Sanctuary – alive! (If the בַּהֶּן גָּדוֹל deliberately performed any part of the אים service improperly, he could lose his life!)

## A מדות Moment

"Do you know how to show your love for someone?" Joshua's father asked him.

"How?" asked Joshua.

"You show your love for someone by completely giving yourself over to them. That's why the פֿהֵן גָּדוֹל invited "his loved ones" - the loved ones of Hashem, - to celebrate surviving the יוֹם כַּפוּר service. Only someone who truly loves Hashem could appreciate that the בַּהַן גָּדוֹל really loved Hashem and showed it by putting his life on the line to serve Hashem on יוֹם כַּפוּר."

### Did You Know...

On יוֹם כְּפוֹר, after the הַרְּוֹם בְּפוֹר, would read from the Torah and recite the closing blessings everyone would bring a Torah scroll from his house and read from it. This would show the beauty of everyone's Torah scroll and would glorify its owner who took pains to make sure the parchment and ink of his Torah was top notch.
